

CAPITAL AREA TABLE TENNIS SUPER LEAGUE

The first seasonal table tennis team league in our area!!

For all ages and levels of play

- Season will run from approximately mid-March through June, with matches every other week
- Teams have a roster of 3-6 players, playing matches against each other (team contests have nine individual matches, 3v3 players for each contest)
- Each team will be placed in a division according to their ratings, with similarly-rated teams
- Each division will have a round robin format, with matches played twice (home and away)
- Division finals will be held at the end of the season
- Cost is \$200 per team – prizes will be awarded to division winners (\$1,000 for top division)
All money is used for prizes and league operational expenses. The league committee is entirely made up of volunteers, who will receive no compensation
- Teams are encouraged to represent a club, but not required
- Teams must have a location/day/time for home matches (contact us if you need ideas), and make arrangements for visiting teams to play at the home venue at no charge.
Team representing busy clubs are encouraged to find alternative venues for home games.
- USATT ratings will be used for initial seeding, afterwards a league rating system will be used
- No USATT membership required to play
